Expenditures to Date

Expense Summary

- This report regards year-to-date expenditures to February 28, 2021
- Total expenditures in 2021 = \$878,316
- Expenditures are underspent compared to the total available budget.
- Available budget for 2021 includes \$20.6 million carried forward from 2020, which has been reallocated for 2021 and future years.
- Areas of significant expected spending in 2021 include Information Technology, Infrastructure, and Recruitment, Assessment and Training.



Impacts

- \$42.8 million available as of the end of February 2021
- Total projected spending for 2021 fiscal year will be approximately \$29.5 million.
- By the end of 2021, SPS expects to carry forward \$14.2M to 2022 and future years.
- Given the requirement to confer broadly with the Province and the Government of Canada the timing of expenditures is not always as precise as planned.

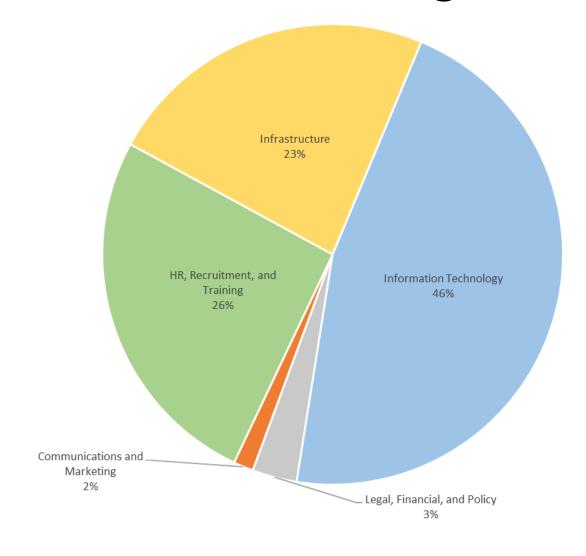

Responsibility

- The Surrey Police Board is an independent entity
 - established by Province of BC
 - governed by the Police Act
- Under the Police Act, the Board and the municipality must:
 - Fund policing and law enforcement
 - By **Nov 30** each year, prepare and submit to council provisional policing budget for the following year.



Budget Preparation Timeline

April

Begin preparation of the provisional budget

June

Begin collaboration with the City of Surrey Finance Team on budget development process

September -October

The Finance Committee and the Board review, refine, and approve the provisional budget













May

Staff begin to compile data to create early draft of the budget

July - August

Work with the City of Surrey to prepare the draft budget

November

The Board submits the Provisional Budget to the City of Surrey for annual budget cycle

 Authorize to initiate the preliminary work on the 2022 provisional budget for SPS
