Expense Summary

- This report regards year-to-date expenditures to April 30, 2021
- Total expenditures in 2021 = \$3,683,784
- Expenditures are underspent compared to the total available budget.
- Available budget for 2021 includes \$20.6 million carried forward from 2020, which has been reallocated for 2021 and future years.
- Areas of significant expected spending in 2021 include Information Technology, Infrastructure, and Recruitment, Assessment and Training.



Impacts


- \$40.0 million available as of the end of April 2021
- Total projected spending for 2021 fiscal year will be approximately \$29.5 million.
- By the end of 2021, SPS expects to carry forward \$14.2M to 2022 and future years.
- Given the requirement to confer broadly with the Province and the Government of Canada the timing of expenditures is not always as precise as planned.
