REPORTING REQUIREMENT	

PURPOSE:

Section 28 of the *Police Act* requires the Surrey Police Board (the "Board") to establish rules consistent with the *Act*, its regulations and the director of policing respecting the standards, guidelines and policies for the administration of the Surrey Police Service ("SPS") and the efficient discharge of duties and functions of SPS and its sworn employees.

POLICY

The Board directs the Chief Constable to establish standards, guidelines and policies, consistent with the *Police Act*, the regulations and standards of the director of policing and law enforcement services, for the following:

- (a) the administration of SPS;
- (b) the prevention of neglect and abuse by SPS sworn officers; and
- (c) the efficient discharge of duties and functions by SPS and SPS sworn officers.
